

<u>Trivia</u>

The term Dutch Courage originated during the bubonic plague of London, in 1665. The city was sealed off to avoid contamination and hence starvation became prevalent. The Dutch were the only ones brave enough to enter the city. The locals would leave money on the end of the jetties and Dutch sailors replaced the money with food.

The Dutch still have freedom of the river Thames to this day.

Whilst we are on a river, it is sometimes thought that the word wharf is an acronym for Whare House Along River Front, probably not correct.

English drive on the left side of the road because mounted soldiers and other horsemen wore their sword on the left side .When another horseman approached , they could shake hands with friends or draw their sword to defend themselves against foes.
