VBA Affiliation Fees.

VBA Affiliation Fees for home members of Affiliated Clubs for the Year from 1 April 2025 have been set at \$20.00. This is an increase of \$3.50 from \$16.50 in 2024. You should be receiving an invoice very soon. Clubs will be aware that the governing bodies in NSW and Queensland have pegged their State Affiliation fees to the schedule adopted by the ABF. The ABF Affiliation Fees will be increasing from \$20 in 2024, to \$23.30 in 2025, \$26.60 in 2026 and \$29.90 in 2027. BV will be considering this when we go through our budget review process in June.
